


































Basic bookbinding, to do even in bed

(Workshop of Jan Haverkate at the HOPE congress 2023 in Milan)

		
<p>1) You will need a square one liter drink carton.</p>	<p>2) Make sure the drink carton is clean and dry.</p>	<p>3) Cut the top straight.</p>
		
<p>4) Fold the entire drink carton so that the opening is in the middle.</p>	<p>5) Fold the drink carton in such a way that there is 6 centimeters left at the top.</p>	<p>6) Cut the corners diagonally, as shown in the picture.</p>
		
<p>7) Cut the corners diagonally, as shown in the picture.</p>	<p>8) This is what the drink carton will look like.</p>	<p>9) Draw a guide line on the inside.</p>

		
<p>10) Open the drink carton.</p>	<p>11) Fold the outer flap.</p>	<p>12) Cut the inner flap off along the guideline.</p>
		
<p>13) Now the drink carton looks like this.</p>	<p>14) Make 10 sheets of 15.3 by 13.0 centimeters.</p>	<p>15) Fold the 10 sheets lengthwise.</p>
		
<p>16) Secure the 10 sheets of paper to the drink carton with four clothespins.</p>	<p>17) These are the tools for making the sewing holes. The piece of wood to protect your table. Use it!!</p>	<p>18) Use the nail to make a hole in the sheets of paper and the drink carton every centimeter. You can use a hammer, stone or stick.</p>
		
<p>19) Check that all the holes are also in the drink carton.</p>	<p>20) Prepare the needle and thread.</p>	<p>21) Start sewing with needle and thread.</p>

		
<p>22) Secure the end of the thread under the clothespin.</p>	<p>23) Continue sewing the paper sheets.</p>	<p>24) Sew to the end of the holes.</p>
		
<p>25) Sew through the holes back to the beginning.</p>	<p>26) Cut the thread about 10 centimeters from the paper.</p>	<p>27) Remove the secured thread from under the clothespin.</p>
		
<p>28) Tie a double knot on both threads.</p>	<p>29) Remove the four clothespins.</p>	<p>30) Remove the plastic cap from the drink carton.</p>

		
<p>31) Fold the loose flap over the opening.</p>	<p>32) Rub the cardboard above the edge of the plastic opening.</p>	<p>33) Mark the circle of the opening with a pen.</p>
		
<p>34) Mark the drawn circle extra clearly.</p>	<p>35) Make a hole in the marked circle.</p>	<p>36) Cut the circle out of the cardboard.</p>
		
<p>37) This is what it looks like now.</p>	<p>38) Fold the booklet closed.</p>	<p>39) Fold the loose flap closed over the plastic opening as well.</p>
		
<p>40) Twist the cap onto the booklet.</p>	<p>41) There is space for cheat sheets on the inside.</p>	<p>42) And the booklet is ready to use.</p>
